This Cookies Policy explains how our website www.excellemagazine.co.uk uses cookies to help distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our site. This policy will also explain what you can do to manage these cookies. By continuing to browse the site, you are agreeing to our use of cookies.

The use of Cookies

Cookies are small text and number files placed on your computer (or other electronic devices) when you access the internet, cookies contain information about the websites you have visited. They allow websites to store things like user preference and personal information. Cookies can be used to gather information about the user's use of the website or enable the website to recognise the user as an existing customer when they return to the website at a later date.

Most browsers automatically accept cookies by default, but users can change these settings to block some or all cookies.

Our website uses cookies to:

- Recognise you whenever you visit the site
- Obtain information about your preferences, online movements and use of the internet
- Make you online experience more efficient and enjoyable

The information we obtain from the use of our cookies may contain traces of your personal information. It will also contain information about your computer (or other electronic devices) in regards to your internet protocol address (IP address), your web browser and other internet log in information.

We use the following cookies:

Strictly necessary cookies. These are cookies that are required for the operation of our website. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to enter your personal details on the 'contact' page.

Analytical/performance cookies. These allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when they are using it. This helps us improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.

Targeting cookies. These cookies record your visit to our website and the links you have followed. We will use this information to make our website more relevant to your interests. We may also share this information with third parties for this purpose.

You can find more information about the individual cookies we use and the purposes for which we use them in the table below:

Name	Purpose	More Information
XSRF-TOKEN	The XSRF-TOKEN provides protection from Cross-site request forgery (CSRF) attacks.	This cookie expires when the browsing sessions ends
svSession	This cookie is used to remember a client when they return to use our website.	This cookie expires two years after its creation
hs	This cookie is a session Cookie.	This cookie expires when the browsing sessions ends
